1. Completed Application Form.
2. Explain in a **200** (minimum and maximum) Word Essay (one page; double-spaced).
  - “*What role the performing arts has played and will play in your life.*” and
  - “*Why you are most deserving of the scholarship?*”
3. Provide a Resume of all your experience in the performing arts **and at Smithfield Little Theatre**
  - Include past roles, technical work and skills; include high school, all community theatre, etc.
  - Provide names, telephone numbers and email addresses of those persons that supervised you, in the event we may need to contact them for information verification or clarification.
4. Three (3)\* specific Letters of Recommendation from the following (adult; from the local area):
  - **a)** one from directors/technicians familiar with your work (*other than school*);
  - **b)** one from a teacher or administrator other than someone in the performing arts (i.e. math teacher);
  - **c)** one from a civic, community or church leader.
